Family Pass: Two adults and their dependent children (age 23 and younger) living at home. Dependents age 18-23 must be full time students.*

Adult Pass: Adult age of 19 - 61 years.

Youth Pass: Youth age of 3-18 years.

Nanny Pass: Families who employ a nanny or babysitter (age 14 or older) during the summer may purchase one nanny pass in addition to their family or youth pass. *Only one nanny pass per household.* Must be purchased in conjunction with a family or youth pass. Pass is valid for only whom the pass is issued to.

(Note: Children 2 & under are free and Seniors 62 and older are free and do not require a pass, but proof of age is required for seniors.)

- All membership passes will include a key tag instead of photo ID. These key tags are "forever" passes, meaning they are not re-issued each year. Please keep your key tag from season to season to avoid having to pay a replacement fee (\$1). All new pool members are required to take a photo. Existing members can use their previous photo and will be asked to update as needed. Everyone with a pass must have a photo on file to gain entrance to the pool. Photos can be taken at City Hall or at the pool admissions counter.
- Lost key tags can be re-issued at Gardner City Hall Mon-Fri from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.
- Memberships can be purchased beginning Feb. 1, 2019.
- Online renewals now available. Must have had a 2018 membership AND an existing online account to renew. See back for online renewal instructions or visit gardneraquatics.com.

Online Renewals

Pool pass renewals are only available to those who had a 2018 pool pass. Must have an online account set up through ActiveNet. To set up account, visit: gardneraquatics.com, click Renew Pool Pass and then click on Create Account.



Once you log into your account at the ActiveNet website, you will either click on the "Membership" tab on the upper left corner of the ActiveNet homepage or go to:

My account > Renew Membership (listed under Other Services heading)

If cannot find some or all of your key tags from 2018, visit the Parks and Recreation window at City Hall to purchase replacement tags for \$1 each. The Key Ring App can be used in place of the tags as long as you have them loaded on the app from last year. Replacement key tags can be purchased at City Hall throughout the summer.

Facility Rules to Remember!

- Children ages 9 and Under MUST be accompanied by a person 14 years of age or older.
- Must be atleast 48" tall in order to go down the slides and ride the lazy river by yourself.
- Swimwear with buckles or any other oversized metal ornamentation will not be allowed on the slides. This includes the front and back sides of suits. Oversized jewelry is also not allowed. Such items will scratch the surface, causing injury to riders.
- Arm floaties are allowed in the kiddie pool and splash playground only.
- Coolers, jugs, food and beverages are not allowed in the facility (with the exception of water).

Family Pool Pass Eligibility

Family pool passes are for immediate family members living in the household only.

Immediate Family is defined as: Two adults and their dependent children living at home. Dependents between the ages of 18 and 23 must be full time students and can show proof of residency at the residential address.

- If an aunt, uncle or grandparent are the legal guardian of the children, then they would be included, however proof of guardianship and residency is required. If they are not the legal guardian, they would not be considered immediate family.
- If a family member such as a niece, nephew or cousin is visiting for the summer, they are not eligible to be on the family's pass

Adult Pass

- An adult pass may be purchased for any adult between the ages of 19 and 61 years.

Youth Pass

- A youth pass may be purchased for any youth between the ages of 3 and 18 years. Please remember that any youth under the age of 9 must still be accompanied by an individual at least 14 years of age.

Nanny Pass

- Families who employ a nanny/babysitter during the summer may purchase one nanny pass in addition to their family or youth pass for \$65. Only one nanny pass per household will be issued per season. The nanny pass must be purchased in conjunction with a family or youth pass . Pass is valid only for whom the pass is issued. Nanny pass is for ages 14 and older.

Daily Admission Tickets

Daily Admission fees can be paid for at the Gardner Aquatic Center front desk, however, if you would like to pre-purchase a Daily Admission ticket, they can only be purchased at Gardner City Hall at our Customer Service Center, located at 120 E. Main St. Hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tickets are non-refundable.
